RULES

1. Only animals which are exhibited in their respective market show, but fail to make the Junior Livestock Auction, may enter the carcass contest. Please see rule #11 for additional information.
2. Only one steer, lamb, pig and goat per exhibitor. Swine entries are limited to 50 hd.
3. Entry fee: \$30.00/head. This will cover entry into the Carcass contest. The fair association will not be responsible for kill fees, chilling fees or any other fees that may be charged by the processing establishment.

5. Contest will take place at Lad's, in Needville, Texas (979-793-6210), Thursday, October 21, 2010. Results of the contest will be posted outside the Livestock Office, Thursday afternoon. (See Livestock Bulletin Board)
6. In response to safety and sanitation concerns, only Carcass Committee members are needed for the carcass judging. Any other persons needed to be present for the carcass judging will be left up to the discretion of the Carcass Committee Chairman.
7. THE EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING THE PACKING HOUSE WITH DISPOSITION INSTRUCTION CONCERNING THE CARCASSES. (CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS OR THE NAME OF PURCHASER, ETC.) CARCASS COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISPOSE OF ALL CARCASSES IF DISPOSITION IS NOT MADE ACCORDINGLY. THE LAD'S ALSO RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISPOSE OF CARCASSES HELD PAST NOVEMBER 1, 2010.
8. EXHIBITORS THAT INTEND TO KEEP CARCASSES FOR THEIR OWN USE ARE TO CONTACT LAD'S (979-793-6210) BY MONDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2010 WITH CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS. IN ORDER TO EXPEDITE PROCESSING OF ANIMALS, EXHIBITORS MAY ALSO COMPLETE CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.
9. **EXHIBITORS, OR A DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ENTRIES BEING LOADED ON THE PACKING COMPANY TRAILER.**

These trailers will be loaded according to the following schedule:

10. Only Grand Champion Carcass winners will sell their Champion Animal Carcasses in the Junior Livestock Auction, provided the two item Limit in the Junior Livestock Auction has not been exceeded.
11. Should an animal that has been entered into the Carcass Contest and already hauled to the processing facility for slaughter and judging, qualify to move into the Junior Livestock Auction, the entry shall be removed from competition in the Carcass Contest. This market animal will then be eligible to be sold in the Junior Livestock Auction. In this instance, the exhibitor will be responsible for kill fee and chill fee at processing establishment. Exhibitor also forfeits Carcass Contest Entry fee to fair association.
