DIVISIONS: Juniors (Boys and Girls) Grades 1-6
Seniors (Boys and Girls) Grades 7-12
Adults (Men and Women) Out of High School
CATEGORIES: MAIN DISH (usually contains a meat or meat alternative such as cheese, eggs, dry beans, etc.)
SIDE DISH (usually served along with a main dish or an accompaniment to the main course)
DESSERT or BREAD

RULES

1. Entries will be accepted on the contest day. Contestants must bring two typed or neatly printed copies of recipe on a 3x5 index card. Recipes become the property of the Fair Association.
2. There will be no heating or cooling facilities or electrical outlets available.
3. The entire dish for recipe should be submitted to contest, not a portion of recipe. (Cut a recipe, if necessary, to size of dish entered).
4. All dishes must be covered with plastic wrap or lids and must have names written with pen on masking tape underneath dish.
5. Contestant may enter as many dishes as desired, and in all categories.
6. Contestants will not be allowed in judging area after 2:30 p.m. until judging is completed.
7. Entries will be judged on the following:
 - a. Recipe Selection 10 Points
(percentage of rice in recipe)
 - b. Texture of Rice 15 Points
 - c. Taste 40 Points
 - d. Appearance 35 Points
8. Awards will be presented at 5:00 p.m. in the Entertainment Hall. All dishes and/or containers must be removed by 5:30 p.m.
9. Committee will not be responsible for dishes and/or containers left after the pickup time of 5:30 p.m.
10. All participants must comply with the Brazoria County Fair Association General Rules and Regulations printed in this catalog, unless otherwise specified.

AWARDS

Silver Tray and Cash Award will be presented to Rice Plus Champion in each age group.
Silver Trays will be presented to the winner of each class.
Rosettes will be presented to first through sixth places.
Additional Prizes may be added to awards list prior to contest.
