

UTILITIES

Water and electric will be available. Exhibitors using commercial equipment such as refrigerator, stoves, or AC units will be charged an additional \$100.00. Any modifications, alterations, or hardwiring of BCFA electrical service/outlets MUST have prior approval from the Brazoria County Fair Association. No exceptions.

PARKING & PASSES

Each 4-H/FFA Livestock group will be given two weekly Passes for entrance to the Fair. Workers will not be allowed inside the Fairgrounds without a valid pass or ticket.

Each 4-H/FFA Livestock group will receive one Commercial "C" Parking Pass to be used for entrance to the grounds for the **initial setup** and allows parking in the Reserved/Commercial parking areas. **NO TRAILERS (storage or live in) will be allowed to stay in the parking area. VEHICLES MAY NOT BE PARKED IN OR BY THE LEASED SPACE.** NOTE: If you will be using a vehicle to enter the Fairgrounds to restock your space your "C" parking permit will allow you to enter the Fairgrounds thru the service gates each day between **8:00 AM to 9:00 AM only.** Your permit must be properly displayed or Security will not allow your to enter the Fairgrounds. A "C" permit does not allow you to remain on the grounds after 9:00 AM.

RESTOCKING MUST NOT CONFLICT WITH SCHEDULED LIVESTOCK SHOWS OR EVENTS - PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY

HOURS

4-H/FFA Livestock Spaces may be set up and available to participants between the hours of 6:00 AM to Mid-Night. Activities in space must not interfere with scheduled Livestock shows or events.

Exhibitors will be allowed on the grounds, Sunday, Oct. 23, 2011, **1:00 AM to 2:00 AM ONLY** to dismantle and remove exhibits. If exhibitor chooses to leave during early exit time, an **EXIT PERMIT** will be required from the Fair Office. Normal dismantling and removal of exhibits will be Sunday, Oct. 23, 2011 from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. **There will be no Security on the grounds after 11:00 AM, Oct. 23rd.** The exhibit space is to be left in original condition. Damages to the leased space will be charged to the Exhibitor.
