RULES

1. All entries and awards in this department are subject to General Livestock and Fair Rules printed in this catalog, unless otherwise specified.
2. Entries must be entered in the exhibitor's name. All broilers must have been purchased in the 2011 central purchase order for the Fair. No entry will be accepted unless exhibitor's name appears on the broiler master list at the time the order was placed.
3. Each broiler presented to the judge must bear a special code wingband. The identification number on the band must fall within the series of numbered broilers assigned to that individual. Broilers losing their wingband, for whatever reason, will not be eligible to show. If the band shows evidence of being tampered with or if the web is torn in any way, the pen will be disqualified.
4. No individual may have more than three (3) entries in Department "G".
5. A pen is to be three (3) broilers. A pen must consist of three live broilers any sex at 6:30 a.m. on October 15, 2011.
6. The Chairman will attend the cooping. Each specimen will be returned to its proper owner, but the Fair Association will not be responsible for loss or damage in any instance. EXHIBITORS WILL FURNISH FEED, FEEDERS, WATER CONTAINERS, AND WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FEEDING AND CARE OF THEIR EXHIBITS. ANY EXHIBITOR FAILING TO FEED, WATER AND KEEP PEN CLEANED WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FAIR AND WILL BE BARRED FROM SHOWING AT NEXT YEAR'S BROILER SHOW. Exhibitors must use two three pound coffee cans or one gallon cans to feed and water their broilers. All cans must be tied to cage.
7. Each exhibitor is responsible for removing water/feed containers from their pen and surrounding area and the same must be free of wood shavings before any release papers will be issued.
8. No private cards or any indication of ownership is to be allowed on the coops until after judging and then nothing which obstructs the view or interferes with other exhibits is to be used.
9. No one except Poultry Committee of the show will be allowed to handle the birds without permission from the owner.
10. No substitution of broilers will be allowed prior to judging.
11. The top 30 pens will remain for the duration of the Fair. Non-placing broilers will be released Sunday, October 16, 2011, between 8:00 am and 10:00 am. During this same time the placing broilers will be re-located to a designated area by the exhibitor. All exhibitors are responsible for removing shavings from the pre-show coops the morning of October 16th. ANY EXHIBITOR NOT ADHERING TO THE RELEASE AND/OR RELOCATION TIMES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE MARKET SALE AND THE JUNIOR LIVESTOCK AUCTION.
12. Exhibitors will be responsible for transporting and penning their own broilers before and after the sift. Each broiler exhibitor will be responsible for holding his/her birds. If the exhibitor or his/her substitute is not present when his/her number is called, his/her birds will not be tabled. Youth exhibitors are preferred holders of broilers.
13. **Only exhibitors and holders allowed in the show ring during show.**
14. Only dry feed will be allowed in cages after judging.
15. In the event that a pen of broilers is sifted by the judge for any reason, each broiler in that pen shall be paint marked by the committee before being returned to the exhibitor. Broilers will be sifted for poor market quality. No marked broiler may be re-entered into the Broiler Show.
16. The Brazoria County Fair shall have the authority to drug test any broiler entered in the fair.
17. Any exhibitor having more than one animal making the sale in this department **must sell the highest placing animal.** In the event two animals have the same placing; the exhibitor must notify the Chairman or Co-Chairman of this department within one hour after the show which one will sell, otherwise the chairman will determine which animal will sell.
18. For exhibitor eligibility requirements, see General Livestock Department rules.

JUNIOR MARKET & COMMERCIAL HEIFER CERTIFICATION FORM

We, the junior exhibitor and parent/guardian here by certify that we have read, understand, and will abide by, all the rules and regulations of the Brazoria County Fair Association. We further certify that we have not administered and to the best of our knowledge, this entry STEER, LAMB, SWINE, BROILER, TURKEY, RABBIT, GOATS, & COMMERCIAL HEIFER (circle all applicable), has not received any substance not approved by the F.D.A. and /or U.S.D.A. for consumption or breeding animals. This entry is not, nor will it be, within any withdrawal time relative to the administration of any drug, chemical or feed additive approved by the F.D.A. and/or the U.S.D.A. by the time such animal(s) is officially weighed or checked in by the show.

If an animal requires emergency treatment while the animal is on the show grounds, only a licensed veterinarian will be allowed to administer any drug, chemical, or feed additive. An exhibitor may choose a licensed veterinarian of his/her choice, but one of the LIVESTOCK SUPERINTENDENTS MUST be notified in advance and he/she MUST BE PRESENT. All treatment costs are the responsibility of the exhibitor. If an animal is treated by a licensed veterinarian while at the show and the medication administered exceeds fifteen (15) days withdrawal time, the animal(s) will be disqualified and not allowed to show. If the disqualified animal is a junior market steer, lamb, swine, broiler, turkey or rabbit, the animal(s) MUST be immediately removed from the show grounds by the exhibitor. Should a placing animal(s) receive treatment requiring a fifteen (15) day or less withdrawal period, the exhibitor will be responsible for the feeding and caring for the animal for the duration of the withdrawal period.

The Brazoria County Fair Association reserves the right to condemn and/or disqualify any animal, either live or slaughtered, found in violation of the use of any drug, chemical, or feed additive as described above and the exhibitor will forfeit all auction sale money if the animal is disqualified. If an animal(s) is disqualified for testing positive and/or the carcass condemned at slaughter, the class placing will not change.
